HURRICANE SANDY - LOCAL STATE EMERGENCY DECLARED

DOVER, NJ, OCTOBER 29, 2012: Mayor James P. Dodd is encouraging all residents of the Town in low lying areas that are traditionally affected by flooding conditions to consider relocating prior to the full onset of the storm. You are asked to make plans with family or friends during this State of Emergency for your safety as well as that of emergency personnel who may have to respond to your location. The Town will be opening a shelter as of 6pm this evening at the Dover High School located at 100 Grace Street. The use of the shelter is voluntary, however should conditions dictate that a mandatory evacuation be necessary you will be notified via Reverse 911.
