



Important Recycling Notice

Please be advised that as of June 1, 2012 there will be a new contractor collecting recyclables in the Town of Dover. Blue Diamond (the town's current Solid Waste hauler) will also be collecting recyclables. Blue Diamond has proven to be an excellent provider for the municipalities trash removal needs for many years and we anticipate the same level of quality service for our recycling.

Blue Diamonds first recycling collection day will be June 1, 2012. Therefore, the recycling collection routes will change and your recycling may be collected at a different time during the day. The recycling collection dates will remain the same. Please refrain from calling the Health Department if you think that your recycling was missed until after 3:30pm in the afternoon as your recycling may not have been missed, but it is just being collected at a different time.

Just a reminder, recyclables must be placed in a rigid container such as; a light gauge steel container, a plastic or galvanized container and shall be furnished with a top or lid to prevent spilling. **Blue Diamond will not collect any recyclables that have been placed out for collection in bags as this will contaminate the load and may be rejected at the disposal facility.** The container should be no more than a 30 gallon container and shall not weigh any more than 50 lbs. when placed at the curb for collection. For those locations found to have recyclables in bags, they will be tagged and left at the location. A Violation / Warning Notice will be sent to the owner of the property advising them of the violation. For those properties found to be repeat offenders, summonses may be issued. Some examples of acceptable recycling containers are shown below.
